## ACCESS & PARKING: Onsite (see plan in annex)

---

- Take the A4, direction Luxembourg/Merl
- Near Esch-sur-Alzette
- Take Exit 4  
CR164 / A13/ Metz / Saarbrücken / Schifflange / Mondercange/ Foetz
- Follow Mondercange
- At Foetz, at the roundabout, take the third exit. Continue along the CR164, direction Mondercange
- Enter Mondercange > Continue on the CR164 / Grand-Rue
- Turn right: CR172 / Rue de Reckange
- Turn left: CR106 / Rue Neuve
- Take the CR106 / Rue de Limpach

Follow signs for the Business Games until you arrive at the Mondercange track.

## ARRIVAL:

---

Participants should go to reception to confirm their team's enrolment and to receive a bag containing:

- 1 T-shirt for daywear
- 1 cap
- 1 50cl bottle of water
- 2 envelopes:
  - An orange envelope for the day: containing refreshment tokens
  - A white envelope for the evening: containing an entry bracelet and a drinks stamping card (four drinks, one of which should be alcohol-free)

Team captains will receive a guide book with all the information needed for the race to take place smoothly.

## DESCRIPTION AND RULES

---

Go-karting will take place at the Mondercange site. Fourteen go-karts are available for you over a time slot of 7 hours 30\*  
Teams of five must make themselves known to the race organisers 15 minutes prior to the race warm-up. Ten minutes before the warm-up you should get changed.

Teams must be complete. Each missing participant leads to a penalty of five circuits added to the race final scores. Points are given to teams following the order of arrival of participants.

Each race lasts 1h30\* and all team members must take part in each race (except in a case of force majeure). Clothing, helmets, and, of course, go-karts, are provided. Points scored from the first to the seventh: 10-8-6-4-3-2-1.

The team with the most points wins. In a case of teams drawing at the end of a tournament, team captains will race again in a five-circuit challenge.

*\* This length of time may be changed depending to the number of participants.*

### Reminder

All team members must drive, which means a minimum of four driver changes

**NB : You are reminded that you must return your outfit and helmet at the end of each race.**

**We would ask teams to be present 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.**

### Système de comptage

- All participants (of each team) must be ready 10 minutes prior to their races
- Each race lasts 1H30
- All participants of teams selected for a race must make at least two track circuits

**The first seven teams in group 1, the first seven teams in group 2 and the eighth best team from the two groups qualify for the final stage.**



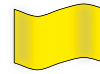
## Flags signification

- Race start : national flag



- Danger : yellow flag

Laying: danger, slow down, overtake forbidden, beginning of a neutral zone

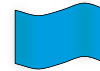


- Overtake: blue flag

Is shown to the pilots that are about to be overtaken with at least one lap late. Its meaning is the following:

Laying: stay on line, overtake in approach by one or many pilots

Waving: major danger, please slow down and allow other pilots to overtake



- Race stop : checkerboard flag



- Warning : black and white flag

Warning for dangerous or unfair play driving



- Race retirement: black flag

The pilot must immediately join closed parking and present to race director.



- Technical problem

The pilot can leave when the problem is fixed



- Race interruption : red flag



## Security reminder :

No overtaking while yellow flag is waving. You might receive a penalty

In case of breakdown, get out of your karting, stand on the lane side and wave up your hand. An assistance karting will come to help you.

Overtaking is forbidden and pilots must slowdown when assistance karting is on the lane, because yellow flags will be waving. The race will start again when green flag will be waved.

When you drive to the pit, raise your arm.

Jumpsuits, helmet and gloves must be fastened, and have to be given back at the end of the round in order to lend it for the other teams.

**Any team which won't give back all of its material will be penalized.  
Every pilot of the team musts drive, which means 4 pilot transfers at least.**

- Unlimited Jalapeno peppers

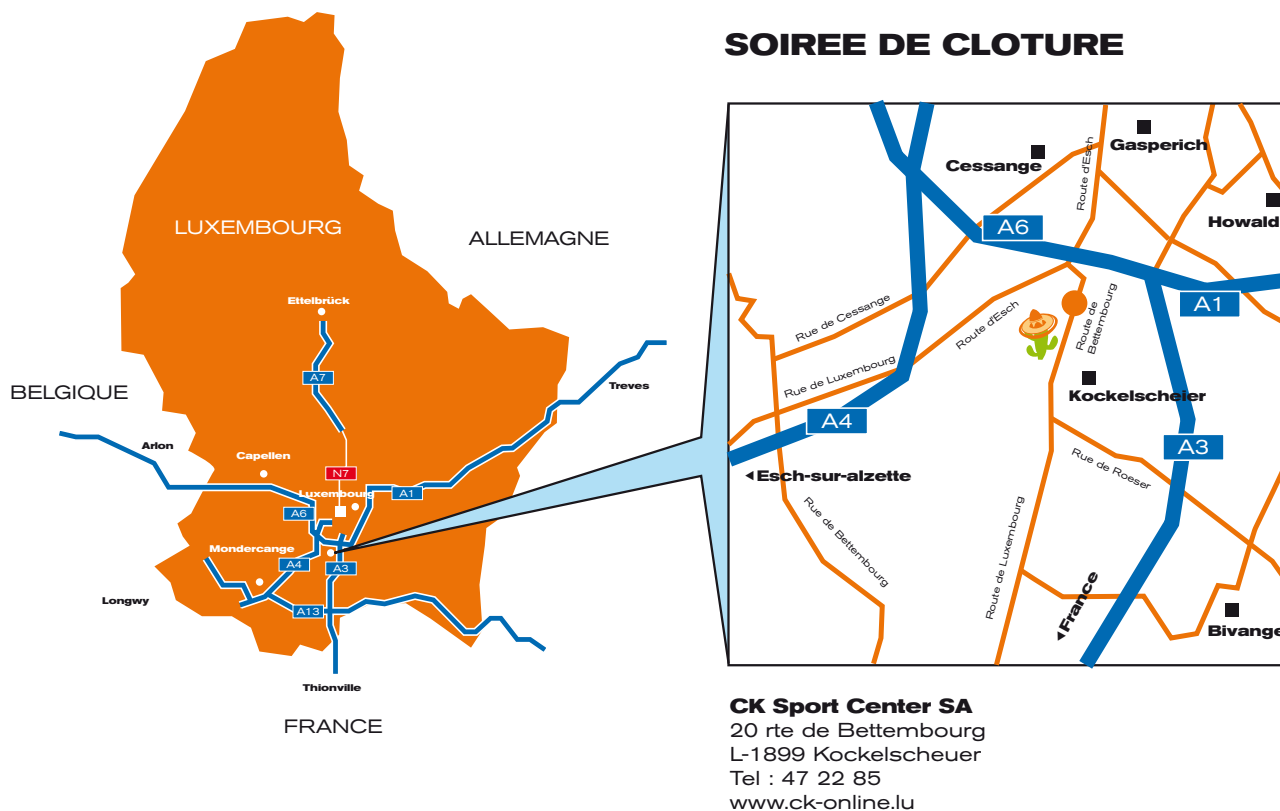
### Desserts
